SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Approved by the Governing Body: Spring 2022

It is our school policy that all children wear and comply with school uniform when attending school or when participating in a school-organised event.

Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- is practical and smart;
- is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by parents;
- is designed with health and safety in mind;
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- promotes a sense of pride in the school;
- engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- identifies the children with the school;
- prevents children from coming to school in fashion clothes that could distract from their learning.

The DfE statutory guidance on school uniform ensures that schools allow both branded and non-branded items of clothing:

Parents can purchase school uniform with our school logo directly from www.yourschooluniform.com.

Parents can purchase our red, white and grey school uniform from a wide variety of high-street shops.

The DfE statutory guidance on school uniform states that schools must make sure that second-hand uniforms are available. Therefore, the school will facilitate second-hand uniform sales during some events that involve parents, for example, the summer fayre.

Health and Safety requirements mean that footwear must securely protect children's feet therefore children are not allowed to wear platform soles, high heels or shoes without a secure heel strap and a secure strap over the foot (e.g. no open ballet shoes, flip-flops). Neither do we allow children to wear trainers or plimsolls to school as this is not in keeping with the smart appearance of a school uniform.

A named bag is essential for holding P.E. clothing. All uniform should be clearly marked with the pupil's name.

The wearing of jewellery and other 'adornments' is not permitted. This includes: all types of jewellery (except sensible watches); all types of earrings and retainers; festival wrist bands; make-up; nail varnish and artificial nails; hair extensions; dyed hair; temporary tattoos and patterns cut into short hair. Watches may be worn but are the responsibility of the wearer and must be removed for PE.

ALL pupils require a plain coloured, waterproof, hooded coat for break-times. A school fleece is also available, for outdoor wear. 'Hoodies' may not be worn in place of a school fleece or coat.

Culottes-style summer dresses <i>which have the appearance of a flared dress</i> may be worn but not the short, jumpsuit style culottes. Plain black, flat, school shoes with either uniform or white flat 'sandals' may be worn with the summer dress (but sandals must not have open toes and they must have secure heel straps)</p> <p>Boys As for Autumn and Spring or <u>grey</u> school shorts (with the appearance of mid-grey, not black) with plain grey or black socks</p>

Kit	<p>White T shirt – available with the school logo – and plain black shorts Black plimsolls Suitable outdoor kit for winter months: sweatshirt-style jumper with <u>no hood</u> and <u>no zip</u> and tracksuit bottoms/joggers (<u>plain, dark</u> colours only please e.g. black, grey, navy blue)</p>

SCHOOL UNIFORM for Key Stage 2: Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

<p>Autumn and Spring Terms</p>	<p>Girls Red V-neck jumper or red cardigan - available with the school logo White, traditional school shirt with the Cold Norton school tie Grey skirt (plain or pleated) or pinafore dress OR grey trousers (not leggings) Black, flat, school shoes (ballet-style shoes without a strap are not suitable for playing outside) White or grey socks (below the knee) OR grey or black tights <u>Plain</u> red, grey, black or red check headbands - long hair must be tied back</p> <p>Boys Red V-neck jumper - available with the school logo White, traditional school shirt with the Cold Norton school tie <u>Grey</u> trousers (with the appearance of mid-grey, not black) Plain black, flat, school shoes (not trainers) with plain grey or black socks</p>
<p>Summer Term</p>	<p>Girls - may continue to wear the Autumn and Spring term uniform OR wear the Summer term uniform. Summer dress: red and white gingham checked dress (gingham check throughout, <u>not</u> a white top and gingham skirt). Culottes-style summer dresses <i>which have the appearance of a flared dress</i> may be worn but not the short, jumpsuit style culottes. Plain black, flat, school shoes with either uniform or white flat 'sandals' may be worn with the summer dress with white socks (but sandals must not have open toes and they must have secure heel straps)</p> <p>Boys As for Autumn& Spring or <u>grey</u> school shorts instead of trousers (with the appearance of mid-grey, not black) with plain grey or black socks</p>

Kit</p>	<p>White T shirt - available with the school logo - and plain black shorts Black plimsolls (trainers may be worn for outdoor PE) Suitable outdoor kit for winter months: sweatshirt-style jumper with <u>no hood</u> and <u>no zip</u> and tracksuit bottoms/joggers (<u>plain, dark</u> colours only please e.g. black, grey, navy blue)</p>
