### Written Statement of Behaviour Principles

- ⊗ Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others.
- ⊗ Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions.
- ⊗ Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times.
- ⊗ Rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy.
- ⊗ The behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff.
- ⊗ The parents/carers of a pupil are informed of incidents of unacceptable behaviour to foster consistency and shared values between the school and pupils' home life.
- ⊗ The behaviour policy explains that exclusions may be used as a last resort where behaviour is persistently unacceptable or in the event of a single, serious incident.
- ⊗ All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination.

The governing board also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour towards staff or pupils will not be tolerated in any circumstances.

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the Curriculum and Pupil-Related Matters Committee every 3 years.
